Chapter 1: Bonds For Energy, Fun and Lasting Impressions

This section is based on the idea that there are three basic needs in every relationship:

Interest, energy and stimulation.

Enjoyment, abundance, expansion of awareness/possibilities and sense of contentment or happiness.

Commitment, consistency, teaching each other, sharing values or reaffirming/confirming something essential in each other.

The sort between your charts is for eleven separate aspects that define energy, fun and lasting impressions between you. Most strong relationships have at least four to six of these aspects between their charts.

Janet's Sun Conj Michael's Mars:

Core Themes: This aspect indicates a challenge to act and to become. It encourages the start of something new, taking pioneering steps or being initiated into some latent aspect of yourself. There is an insistent, even impulsive energy generated when you are together. You will feel stimulated or even compelled in some important way. Chapter 2: Emotions and Communication

The following aspects detail the quality of your emotional connection, your basic level of comfort and your ease or difficulty in communicating, and discussing emotions and simply understanding where each of you is coming from. Additionally, these aspects help describe how you reason together and resolve issues or problems.

Janet's Moon in Aries, and Michael's is in Pisces:

Core Themes: Dissimilar emotional needs are indicated and to some extent different dispositions. Chapter 3: Fulfilling Each Other's Relationship Needs

Janet's Sun Square Michael's 7th house ruler, Mercury:

Core Themes: The intent of this aspect is to have you communicate with strength, warmth and laughter without letting stubbornness get in the way. And this aspect encourages you to express your opinions with the same dignity, certainty, courage and healthy self-esteem that you also allow others.

One of you can be particularly encouraging and lend enthusiasm for the ideas of the other. Janet's Mars Square Michael's 7th house ruler, Mercury:

Janet's MC Conj Michael's 7th house ruler, Mercury:

Initially, you will become interested in each other through some form of communication, or situation of learning, writing or social networking. Michael's Uranus Trine Janet's 7th house ruler, Venus:

You are initially interested in each other because one or both of you are original thinkers, ahead of the pack and ahead of your time. Together you can become representatives or catalysts for awakening others to a new viewpoint or perspective, hopefully positive. This is an aspect of individuality, which means there is the chance that something about your business goes against convention or is advanced and unusual in some way. The two of you can be involved in a cutting-edge type of career or occupation, since your interests lean toward the innovative, avant-garde and progressive. You seek equally creative types to mingle with.

Chapter 4: Your Closest Contacts, Your Strongest Themes

This section interprets the closest connections between your charts. The wisdom of this section says that the closest aspects explain the major or central themes of your relationship and the reason you have come together. The nature of these aspects will also define the main activities, interests and patterns that affect your relationship life together.

Notice that, in this section, each paragraph contains both the easier expression of energies and the more challenging ones. Both interpretations are included because these close connections pertain to the central learning curve of your relationship. Based on the premise that the more exact the connection (also the closest energetic contact) between your pair of planets, the more psychologically significant the aspect will be for each of you. This means that you are likely to be strongly influenced by each other in the areas described. Because of this, it will be useful to consider both the easier and more challenging interpretations even though you lead with one of them. You will, from time to time and in various circumstances, probably exhibit some elements of each interpretation, both the easier expressions as well as the more challenging ones. Another thing - it's possible with both types of aspects that you will have the same challenges but simply respond or react to them in different ways. The goal is to rise to the best possible expression of each combination. This is the learning curve and this bestows the necessary wisdom to develop your relationship.

Janet's Sun Square Michael's Mercury (challenging aspect):

Core Themes: If this is your most exact aspect, the primary theme of your relationship involves communication and connecting with others through: curiosity, thinking and perspectives, versatility, variety of activities, and the gathering and distributing of information.

Challenging aspects: Communication is an integral ingredient in your relationship but at times getting your point across can be frustrating. Challenging aspects: There are gentleness, affection and tolerance that are easily expressed in your friendship. Your mutual attraction happens more on an energetic level initially. Whatever the case, you are likely to have interesting conversations about life and spiritual practice.

Participation in and appreciation of the arts seems a natural and vital part of your lives. One of your gifts is the ability to inspire and smooth over the inevitable hurts and pains of life through understanding and compassion.

Easier aspects: This aspect confers potential flashes of brilliance and innovation in thoughts and ideas. You are likely to lead the pack with your progressive advantage and ability to take a wider perspective. Truthfulness is a high value in your business partnerships and will play a key role in all your business dealings. Although each of you is likely to be very opinionated you always respond to the truth of the matter under discussion. In your business practices your talent lies in making up your own minds about what your business stands for and how you conduct yourselves with clients and the community. You do not suffer from needless worry about what others will think. You speak with originality and creativity and a truthfulness that is hard to deny. Your forward-looking, cutting edge sensibilities are your best assets.

Michael's Moon Trine Janet's Asc. (easier aspect):

Core Themes: If this is the most exact aspect between your charts, your main relationship theme concerns the comfort you feel with the emotional expression or its lack in your relationship. You will be acutely aware of and receptive to each other's emotional state, the feelings of others and the quality of your immediate surroundings.

Janet's Venus Trine Michael's Uranus (easier aspect):

Easier aspects: You express true humanity, treat others fairly, know how to be a great friend and possess a sense of humor - all qualities that will earn you support and influence. You own your own unique style and you tolerate differences in others. Those who know you respect your integrity, as well as your obvious acceptance of the original or creative. In business, you look into

the future more than most and you catch the pulse of the times. You're always the first one to support an innovative idea. It is you that others will emulate. Slicing through the confusion and arriving at the crystal clarity of truth in any situation is your special gift in the business world. You will likely have many diverse friendships, since you value innovative and self-styled people. Your controversy has charm, and when you stand up for a cause, others will listen, because they'll sense an innate truthfulness. Michael's Moon Opp Janet's Uranus (challenging aspect):

Core Themes: If this is the most exact aspect between your charts, your main relationship themes concern the need for freedom, authenticity, independence, truthfulness and creative self-expression. Human rights and basic human freedoms for all people are recurring issues.

Challenging aspects: This combination indicates abrupt shifts and changes in mood and temperament. Sometimes these shifts in perspective or position are exciting and innovative but clearly at other times they can be disruptive and unpleasant. Make sure your wish to change the status quo is grounded in reason otherwise it is likely to spoil your profitability or even your reputation. Being unpredictable or mired in controversy can create some publicity nightmares for you, if you're not careful.
