In many of the interpretations, I've described the highest potential that one can strive for with a particular combination. Yet this is only a potential and being human we have complex emotions and contradictory issues and reactions at any given time in our lives. Use this report as a guide to make your relationships as rewarding and fulfilling as you possibly can while knowing that your relationships are simply mirroring your own soul's struggles. Each relationship will fulfill something within you and challenge you to look at your shadow and transform yourself. Sometimes this means staying in a relationship and sometimes the learning process requires that you let the relationship go. These decisions are never easy and they should only be made after careful and truthful introspection, reflection and guidance. But ultimately, these decisions are yours and yours alone to make. Remember that although you may have some difficult areas of relating with a particular person, it is in those areas that you can learn the most about yourself and others and grow in wisdom. It would be a mistake to look for a business partner or friend with whom you have no disagreements at all and this kind of relationship is a fantasy, rarely if ever, a reality.

Chapter 1: Bonds For Energy, Fun and Lasting Impressions

This section is based on the idea that there are three basic needs in every relationship:

Interest, energy and stimulation.

Enjoyment, abundance, expansion of awareness/possibilities and sense of contentment or happiness.

Commitment, consistency, teaching each other, sharing values or reaffirming/confirming something essential in each other.

The sort between your charts is for eleven separate aspects that define energy, fun and lasting impressions between you. Most strong relationships have at least four to six of these aspects between their charts.

John's Asc in Aries and Yoko's 7th House in Aries:

Core Themes: With this aspect, you will feel an easy natural relating when you are together. Although your approaches may differ, you will often complement each other. The intent of this aspect is to focus and strengthen your ability to relate harmoniously without giving up individuality within relationship. The ASC's personality reflects what the DSC person is in part seeking from relationship with others and vice versa.

Even though it's true that your natural approaches to people and projects differ, you have much to offer each other in a complementary way. What one overlooks the other will pick-up and vice versa until before you know it; you operate like a well-oiled machine. Be sure to give praise and credit where it's due, so as to avoid getting locked into only a single way to get things done. If you're working together on a project, play to each other's strength, allow each other to take on the role most suited and you will win the day. This is the classic "complementary opposites" situation, with a great deal to offer both of you.

John's MC in Capricorn and Yoko's 4th House in Capricorn:

Core Themes: The interplay of career and domestic issues will be one primary focus in your interactions with each other. You are also likely to debate the merits of both external and inner needs, expressions or expectations, at length. One intention of this aspect is to encourage you to find just the right balance between your worldly or external achievements and your personal levels of contentment, as well as domestic harmony. The community environment, what it means to you and how you want to participate in it, together or separately, will also be the subject of discussion.

With this aspect there is a good indication that you can be buddies both at work and off the job. You will often take opposite views on how to manage and organize situations or projects. However, with some patience and skill you can each fill in what the other lacks or where one of you has a blind spot. More than likely you will seek the same outcome in many situations but will tend to go about achieving the goal in very different ways.

John's Sun Conj Yoko's Asc.:

Core Themes: There is an instant awareness or recognition of each other's essential personality. This is an aspect of enhancement, advancement, growth and development of your ability to express yourselves fully. The intent of this aspect is to make you both more aware of your unique ability to demonstrate your talent and discover meaning in your chosen life direction. In general, you benefit each other.

It's as if you recognize or realize more about yourselves in the presence of the other. You feel enhanced, acknowledged and seen. There's a spotlight on you and you're at center stage. There is an even greater potential to express your talents as a team. Encouragement and generosity are part of your typical interaction. Be aware that one person may wish to be the leader or direct the other. This could create hurt pride and an imbalance. Alleviate the situation by taking turns leading and following and make sure to be open and honest with your likes and dislikes. This is an aspect of high visibility, so even if there is disagreement, it will be just as noticeable as when you are in complete sync. You can be a source of strength and support for each other, so much so that your careers or projects can be promoted through the endorsement of the other.

John's Moon Trine Yoko's Asc.:

Core Themes: There is an easy outlet for the expression of emotions in your relationship and your association will have a strong emotional component. Provided you can handle the extra measure of emotional sensitivity, your relationship is enhanced by support of each other's feelings. The intent of this aspect is to increase your caring and nurturing capacities with each other and those whose lives you touch. Compassion and understanding in action is an important feature of your relationship.

You are likely to enjoy many of the same activities and have a unique and relaxed understanding of each other, that makes being with together very comfortable. Interfacing with others and the public at large is an important additional and easy way the two of you relate when you are together. People, the public and social issues are not only of interest to you but you're natural with the public. Most people will find you caring, compassionate and sincere, because somehow you are able to put yourselves in the other person's shoes. Business activities involving the public or any aspect of community concerns including finances and housing, commodities and commerce will be easy for you as a team.

John's Moon Conj Yoko's Saturn:

Core Themes: This aspect indicates that there's seriousness about each other and the quality of your relationship. One meaning of this combination is that you have some important work to accomplish together and you could even go into business together, otherwise conduct business or use each other's services. You are likely to feel a strong commitment and bond with each other that resonates with your own root values. The intent of this aspect is to increase a sense of respectfulness and to develop or reaffirm standards of integrity.

A serious tone, a sense of responsibility, comes into play between you when you are together. This can be positive or it can put a damper on things, depending on what each of you wants from the other. There is a mutual urge for establishing a solid commitment or at least creating rules of engagement for your association or business relationship. Discussions of finances will likely arise early in the relationship. This partnership works best if there are clear structures that both of you agree upon. Important issues in your alliance concern

responsibility, accountability, maintaining integrity, timeliness and keeping promises. It's also possible that you may become involved in a certain amount of stabilization, growing a business plan or directing others. As a team, others view you as firm, reliable and dependable. You may be sought out for advice and counsel because others find you responsible or even wise.

Yoko's Venus Square John's Jupiter:

Core Themes: The intent of this aspect is to expand the full potential of your creative expression while still taking into account possible consequences and risk factors. There is no expansion or expression without universal feedback and this aspect teaches you responsibility for your use of energy, your own, or others. You seek variety, as this is a renaissance energy and you can tolerate a fair amount of risk-taking. Your over-optimism, however, and somewhat laissez-faire attitude, are like wearing rose-colored glasses and you'll need to take them off now and then to deal with the important practical realities of life.

Essentially positive, expansive, generous and joyful, this aspect between your charts generates its share of exaggeration and excess, if not handled carefully. This is the classic, "too much of a good thing". The truth could be inflated, unnecessary risks taken with resources or sometimes by adopting a lazy or careless attitude. Guard against taking too much for granted, or misjudgment because you may easily lose something that's valuable. If expectations are too high, or you've promised more than you can deliver, it could damage your business reputation. Be aware of boasting or showing off, since it is likely to bring you the opposite of what you want. The general impulse is for improvement in your business associations. However, the compulsion of this aspect may be to get it all at once. Take the time to discern the experiences and influences that really matter and look at the long term, at least part of the time. There will always be the urge to push the envelope, and it's up to the two of you to decide when that's in the best interests of business or not.

Yoko's Mars Trine John's Jupiter:

Core Themes: The intent of this aspect is expansion of knowledge and aptitude through a variety of learning adventures including writing, publishing, promotion, sales, sports or religion. The end result is to attain wisdom and a greater capacity for self-expression - "to be the best you can be". The impulse is for improvement and breaking previous records or boundaries in whatever field you choose.

You are together to motivate, expand and develop your project, to take charge and lead yourselves and others into new territories of experience in your business goals - mentally or even spiritually. You can spread optimism according to your means and you may be philanthropic. There's great joy, good will and possibility in this combination and, as partners, the two of you will continually see the silver lining in any black clouds that drift your way. In a business partnership, benefit and opportunity comes to you from this association. Whatever project you are working on, the impetus is to expand its influence and develop connections to further promote and publicize the product or service. It is your positive attitude that will earn the support of others. Don't make the mistake of resting on your laurels. Be sure to maintain the quality of your product or service.

John's Mars Conj Yoko's Asc.:

Core Themes: The immediacy of this aspect can be stimulating or disconcerting. Either

way, it will initiate a greater awareness of yourself in relation to people and situations around you. The intent of this aspect is to fire up your energies and galvanize your self-assertive capabilities. It encourages self-understanding, initiation and self-protection if necessary.

One of you may have a strong instant appreciation for the qualities of the other and begin an assertive pursuit to initiate a relationship. The ASC person however, may find the Mars person too aggressive and disagreements over what to do and how to do it can easily arise between you. Whatever the issues are, how one or both of you uses or misuses your energy, assertiveness or anger will come up for review. You will need to take turns meeting each other's agenda or goals. If one of you is always leading and calling the shots or choosing the activities the two of you will participate in, the other will eventually rebel. The intent of this combination of forces is to awaken you to take action on your own behalf. It stimulates self-assertion by challenging your sense of identity. Although this process is not always comfortable, it will get you moving, sometimes by raising your anger. This is a challenging and competitive business combination.

Chapter 2: Emotions and Communication

The following aspects detail the quality of your emotional connection, your basic level of comfort and your ease or difficulty in communicating, and discussing emotions and simply understanding where each of you is coming from. Additionally, these aspects help describe how you reason together and resolve issues or problems.

Yoko's Moon in Sagittarius, and John's is in Aquarius:

Core Themes: Similar emotional needs are indicated, as are, to some extent, comparable dispositions. Daily habits can coincide, making it easier to share the same physical spaces for long periods of time. In matters of timing, it is likely that you will have similar understandings and be more in agreement than not. The intent of this aspect is to find your way to emotional understanding and harmony and to respect the feelings of the other person.

You are blessed with a similar overall emotional style and disposition, which makes understanding each other and working together easier. You share some of the same rhythms and personal habits or predilections that make daily contact more comfortable. Timing will not be as much an issue, in that you can more easily and quickly respond to each other's levels of excitement or emotional energy and empathize with each other's disappointments. You will feel met by the other because you're very much on the same wavelength. Environments that comfort and support you are more often similar than not, for your associate or business partner. Social connections and the types of people you choose to interact with tend to be of the same general type. And you will appreciate the fact that you share many interests and are able to enjoy numerous activities together. This is not to say that at times you won't be totally perplexed by each other's reactions because, of course, there are other factors in each of your personalities that must be considered.

John's Mercury Trine Yoko's Mercury:

Core Themes: Shared perspectives or styles of problem solving, even communicating, are the hallmark of this aspect. The intent of this energy combination is to facilitate communication, speaking, reasoning and so forth, in order to swiftly and creatively resolve issues, find solutions to problems that arise and create original ideas.

There are many different ways to communicate and the two of you seem to be on the same wavelength most of the time. In other words, your business partner or associate understands and responds well to your style and method of reasoning, thinking and expressing your thoughts and ideas. You usually have the benefit of making yourselves understood the first time, without rehashing and reiterating endlessly. Of course, you won't agree on everything all of the time, but coming to agreement on issues important to you or perceiving what the other wants to communicate will be easier. Your styles of intelligence are also similar and your preferences for mental stimulation could be the same. Teamwork is favored because when you put your heads together, you're more likely to arrive at a creative solution you can both live with than either of you could accomplish separately.

Chapter 3: Fulfilling Each Other's Relationship Needs

These aspects explain how you meet each other's needs in important business or friendship partnerships. These aspects are based on what your natal chart describes that you're looking for in any major one-on-one relationship interaction.

Yoko's Sun Opp John's 7th house ruler, Venus:

Core Themes: The intent of this aspect is to find value in your talents and abilities and develop them until you reach a level of success and satisfaction. Gaining recognition for your skills and building alliances is another way this aspect stimulates.

One of the purposes of this contact is to teach you the finer points of negotiating between independence and teamwork. To have a healthy business relationship, you will want some of each. There is genuine appreciation for each other and you are proud of each other's accomplishments most of the time. There will be moments when you can feel upstaged by your partner, and you may not take this graciously. Be sure that you feel secure with your role in the business collaboration. If not, negotiate different terms. Mostly, the energies you generate create harmony and fairness between you and in your business dealings with others. The equitable functioning of your relationship, the supportive teamwork you're building and what you accomplish as partners can become a matter of great pride. The two of you will want to be visible and you'll gravitate to the appropriate social situations to develop loyal friends and clients. Appearances are important to one or both of you and you are likely to pay close attention to how you promote yourselves and your business.

Yoko's Mercury Opp John's 7th house ruler, Venus:

Core Themes: The intent of this aspect is to open communication between you and keep it open to facilitate the discussion of ideas and interests that motivate you and then, share those interests with others. Consideration and compromise to negotiate for value and comfort are indicated.

Stimulating and intelligent conversation is a mainstay of your business partnership. Activities relating to travel, writing, the arts, advertising, lecturing, marketing are also likely. In fact, the ability to discuss many topics is probably what drew the two of you together in the first place. Wit, word play and joking will keep you both laughing and will create many shared memories and make working together a pleasant experience. Being business partners will put to good use the fair and open communication you share. If you choose to become collaborators, the natural willingness to give time and ideas to new projects will be a big bonus. The tendency will be to continue to build more and more value into the product or service you provide by accepting feedback and remaining alert to changes and responses from clients.

Yoko's Neptune Conj John's 7th house ruler, Venus:

Core Themes: The intent of this aspect is a heightened sensitivity, caring and compassion for the human element pervasive in all of daily life. This combination also serves to inspire through faith, belief, heightened awareness and giving.

Your connection together was probably initially based on an instinctive feeling of

wanting to know more about this person or sensing that this person's sensibilities matched your own. You like the way your associate conducts himself or herself. Trouble starts if you typecast your business partner in some ideal role of your own design that you've manufactured in your mind and if you cannot allow your partner to play other roles or deviate from your ideal. No one can live up to someone else's notion of reality day in and day out. Appreciate the qualities you were attracted to in the first place, talk about your ideal future goals and determine whether you can both meet them. The arts in all their many forms can play an important role in your lives. If they do, then you will have the best of both worlds and a unique partnership that brings great pleasure to both of you. Find a way to give back to the community as a thank-you for their support of you and as a gesture of good will and acknowledgement of interconnectedness.

John's Jupiter Trine Yoko's 7th house ruler, Mars:

Core Themes: The intent of this aspect is to teach you good judgment after some useful experiences of impulsive poor judgment. This combination is positive, generous and inspiring. You can exceed your goals if you heed the wisdom of the situation.

You'll be drawn to each other's enthusiastic and positive spirit. Continual learning and new experiences are activities that you will seek out regularly in your business association. Expansion and growth are attributes your energy is best at, so apply it there. Your natural enthusiasm, however, can have you overextend your energy or resources, so be fully aware and consider the consequences of what you can handle, given your available resources and time. Additionally, overextending yourselves in any way can generate anger and eventual disappointment in your relationship. When the promise of positive outcomes sours, doesn't materialize and becomes stressful one too many times, the fun leaves very quickly and resentments set in. You can prevent this with some foresight and planning in your activities together. Broaden your horizons with confidence but avoid hyperbole. Make a gargantuan effort to deliver on your promises to customers or else don't make promises but simply offer good value for the price.

John's Saturn Trine Yoko's 7th house ruler, Mars:

Core Themes: The intent of this aspect is to help you define the goals and actions that are most important for you to pursue. This aspect teaches you to organize and structure your time and bring disciplined or focused energy to bear.

When you first meet, you will notice the sense of credibility and competence you feel from each other, and it is these qualities that will encourage a stronger association. However, in time, you could just as easily sense that your partner is competing with you or possibly wanting to control the action. Whatever the case, you will feel that there is something important happening between you. Discovering exactly what that is will preoccupy your attention and keep you in relationship to each other in some way. This aspect challenges both of you to define your bottom line and determine when to stand firm and when to yield to appropriate pressure. You can expect some obstacles to be negotiated and overcome. Making a commitment to a course of action and accepting the consequences of your decisions are other lessons that this combination teaches. Once the two of you are in agreement, building the foundation of any project or pursuing any endeavor will bring out your strength, determination and desire for a long-term association or business partnership.

Chapter 4: Your Closest Contacts, Your Strongest Themes

This section interprets the closest connections between your charts. The wisdom of this section says that the closest aspects explain the major or central themes of your relationship and the reason you have come together. The nature of these aspects will also define the main activities, interests and patterns that affect your relationship life together.

Notice that, in this section, each paragraph contains both the easier expression of energies and the more challenging ones. Both interpretations are included because these close connections pertain to the central learning curve of your relationship. Based on the premise that the more exact the connection (also the closest energetic contact) between your pair of planets, the more psychologically significant the aspect will be for each of you. This means that you are likely to be strongly influenced by each other in the areas described. Because of this, it will be useful to consider both the easier and more challenging interpretations even though you lead with one of them. You will, from time to time and in various circumstances, probably exhibit some elements of each interpretation, both the easier expressions as well as the more challenging ones. Another thing - it's possible with both types of aspects that you will have the same challenges but simply respond or react to them in different ways. The goal is to rise to the best possible expression of each combination. This is the learning curve and this bestows the necessary wisdom to develop your relationship.

Yoko's Venus Square John's Jupiter (challenging aspect):

Core Themes: If this is the most exact aspect between your charts, your main relationship theme is to enjoy good fortune and affection in your relationships. There is luck or opportunity (not always recognized) that comes with this combination, including the ability to get what you need when you want it.

Challenging aspects: Your natural business posture is generous and giving, but budgeting your resources is not your strong suit. The desire for instant gratification crops up regularly and you will need to deal with it effectively. Some things are worth waiting for, believe it or not! You have a tendency to risk with high stakes or expectations and your disappointments can be large. Learning to do the research and curb impetuosity will save you grief and protect your bottom line. If you exaggerate or make false claims, you're likely to gain a bad reputation. Your negative issues arise mostly from overdoing or overspending in one way or another. In spite of it all, you manage to laugh about your escapades and also find some wisdom in misfortune. Your greatest wisdom however, is to minimize your misfortune.

Easier aspects: Your energy together exudes goodwill and generosity, and others will respond positively toward you and want to be part of your successful ventures. You have the capacity to charm others to support your business projects and you also have the track record that investors look for. Financially too, you will be more abundant than not. Your social philosophy is the best ambassador to sell your products or services. A little generosity goes a long way in securing loyalty from your clients. There is a tendency to overdo, over-care and overspend yourselves and resources, but if you have it to spend, it's your choice. You may find others jealous of your good fortune in spite of your generosity, but that's their problem. The worst thing that can happen is that you become arrogant or feel entitled to be treated as special at all times. If you persist in this kind of attitude your popularity, will quickly fade.

Yoko's Uranus Conj John's Asc.:

Core Themes: If this is the most exact aspect between your charts, your main relationship theme is to express yourselves freely without excessive constraint and without automatically conforming to societal expectations. You support truth and human rights.

Challenging aspects: Your natural tendency to attract controversy could turn into a foolish need to gain negative attention or simply to irritate your competition. This is never a good enough reason to take an initiative. It's the "rebel without a cause" syndrome and is a waste of your efforts. If you're going to make a ripple in time or at least in your business circles, make sure you are either defending an inalienable right or presenting a brilliant innovation. Simply making statements that attract attention or create a scene will quickly earn you the reputation of being a "loose cannon". Sometimes, this method works in your favor, but most times it is disruptive and damages your reputation. Work at smoothing some of your rough edges, and your original and timely message may actually penetrate the consciousness of those you seek to influence. You bring out the strong will in each other, which doesn't easily lend itself to the compromises necessary in a business relationship. Still, if you want to be a team, you'll need some rules to go by.

Easier aspects: In your business relationship, you are seen as innovators and team players. You prefer the power of the group and consensus to make decisions and reach conclusions. Others may be fascinated and inspired with your boldness, your willingness to go against the grain and be controversial. You automatically sort for innovative means, methods and solutions and those that help the most people in an honest way. One of the best skills you have in terms of business is your social instinct. Acceptance of differences in style, ethnicity and any other human variable will earn you respect in your circle because you go beyond the limited viewpoints often in place. You tend to be very much who you are without putting on any social airs. People will respect your truthfulness and enjoy knowing that they can count on your honest opinion. Your approach may earn you some raised eyebrows initially but in the long run, your methods will be emulated.

Yoko's Venus Square John's Saturn (challenging aspect):

Core Themes: If this is the most exact aspect between your charts, your main relationship theme concerns the values of seriousness, timing, integrity, trust, commitments and contracts of various kinds.

Challenging aspects: It's possible there are obstacles to commitment or contracts in business that will frustrate both of you. Timing can be an issue - you may wait too long and delay your decision until the opportunity has passed. Trial and error will teach you a rhythm of timing and when making a move or taking action feels right to you. Avoid negative criticism of yourself and others, because it is counterproductive. It's also only part of the whole picture. Look for the solution instead of focusing on the problem. You will need to learn to make difficult decisions with grace. The biggest pitfall with this aspect is discouragement -- thinking that difficulties will perpetuate more difficulties or being too harsh in your attitudes. Get professional assistance if you're stuck in any major aspect of your business. Allow the detached perspective of the professional to help you get a handle on your organizing.

Easier aspects: You are typically cautious when getting involved in business contracts or partnerships and seek trustworthiness and integrity in others. However, these are qualities that you are also willing to abide by. You feel most content with familiar, time-tested and

consistent patterns or habits and with creating financial and emotional security. The stability of formal business contracts appeals to your careful and methodical nature. As a team, you are well organized and reliable and tend to keep your word. Others will seek out these admirable abilities. You will be offered positions of responsibility and leadership, and your sense of timing is excellent. Your standards are high, and your striving for excellence will earn you top-shelf positions in commerce and in the community. Others will follow your lead.
